

# Meteor Minutes with Mrs. Moyer November 2022

#### November- A month of Thanks

October was a month packed to the brim with all sorts of activities! On Wednesday, October 5th we had the Real Men Read program from the United Way at our school to read to our Kindergarten students. On Thursday, October 6th we had 5th and 6th grade students travel to the High School to hear Ryan's Story, a presentation by Mr. John Halligan. Halligan's presentation covered lessons regarding how to deal with cyberbullying, bullying, and teen depression.

On Thursday, October 6th we held Fire Prevention Day. Companies represented included: Silver Lake Volunteer Fire Company, Forest Lake Volunteer Fire Company, Little Meadows Volunteer Fire Company & Rescue Squad, and Snake Creek Volunteer Fire Company. We conducted a fire drill with Fire Company response and had an assembly for grade levels with stations put on by members of the fire companies in attendance. Some examples of stations included: practicing stop, drop, and roll, learning the right motion to operate a fire extinguisher, getting to go inside an ambulance and fire truck, learning about the tools on both, learning about the suit and equipment firefighters wear, understanding how to call 911 if there were a fire, planning for a meeting place at your home if there were a fire and more. The day was full of valuable reminders and lessons for our students and we are very grateful to all of the Fire Companies involved for their dedication and hard work to make this day possible for our students.

We opened our Time Capsule from 1996 that was put in the ground at the 25th Anniversary celebration. Happy 50th CVES! We are working on a section of the website that will have pictures/information from the Time Capsule. Students and past faculty/staff got to see the contents of the Time Capsule and got to present the new items going into our time capsule that will be opened in 2046, at our 75th Anniversary!

We celebrated Unity Day by wearing orange and talking about unity and acceptance on October 19th. We also celebrated Red Ribbon Week October 24-28th with a theme of Celebrate Life: Live Drug Free and Make Healthy Choices. Each day held a different theme for how students could dress to take part in our celebrations.

We held Big Ideas Family Night to share information about Big Ideas Math Curriculum, i-Ready, FOCUS Parent Portal, Remind Parent Communication App, and more. Families could have dinner here provided free of charge by the Nutrition Group and could also choose from clothes donations from Plato's Closet and Once Upon a Child.

Archery has started up for grades 3-6. Forms went home about youth wrestling. Boys and Girls Travel Basketball for 5th and 6th Grade has begun. Manic Monday and Wacky Wednesday clubs are running. Computer Clubs for 5th and 6th graders are just about wrapped up. It's so exciting that there are so many opportunities for our students to learn and grow outside of the classroom.

As we head into the Thanksgiving holiday in a few weeks, I am feeling extra thankful to be a part of Choconut Valley Elementary School, to be surrounded by a wonderful and dedicated faculty/staff, for impressive students, and supportive families. Thank you for all you do at home so that we can be partner's in your child's educational process.

If you have any questions/concerns, please don't hesitate to reach out. I am sending you wishes for a great November and a wonderful Thanksgiving. December will be here before we know it!




